

The Figure S1 is representing the world's map showing the production scenario of citrus in the world (FAO 2017). So, China, Brazil, India, United States and the region surrounding these countries produces the highest quantity of citrus (Figure 1).

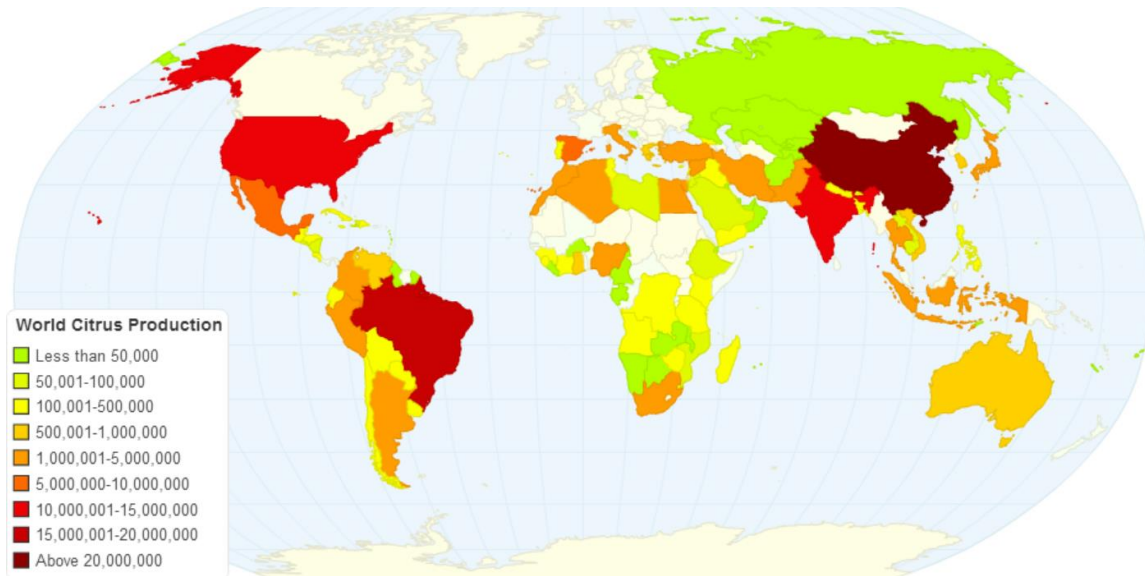


Figure S1. The citrus-producing countries around the world (FAO 2017). (Internet source: <http://chartsbin.com/view/37266>).

According to Food and agriculture organization (FAO) statistical data of 2017 the world's citrus production was 124,246.0 thousand tons (TT) and China stands first with highest production about 32,705.9 TT and shares 26.3% of world's total citrus produced followed by Brazil.
