




## Supplementary Materials: Improving Uptake and Sustainability of Sanitation Interventions in Timor-Leste: A Case Study

Stakeholders were asked to indicate their level of agreement or disagreement with eight statements relating to the roll-out of interventions in communities. Responses were graded from 1–5, with 1 and 2 indicating strong disagreement and disagreement respectively (**Figure S1**, orange bars), and 4 and 5 indicating agreement and strong agreement respectively (**Figure S1**, green bars); 3 indicated a neutral response to the statement (**Figure S1**, grey bars).
