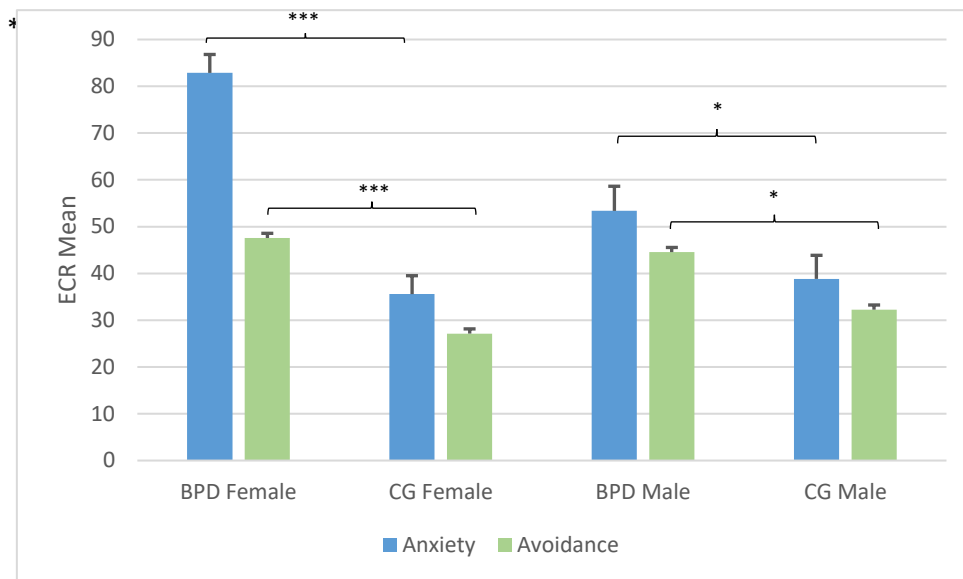
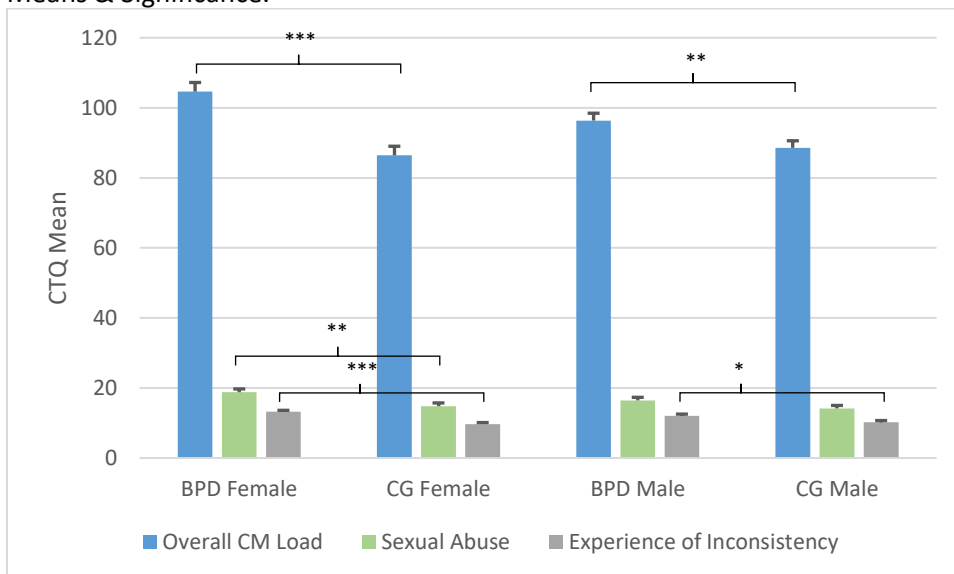


Figure S1. Attachment Parameters: Marginal Means & Significance.



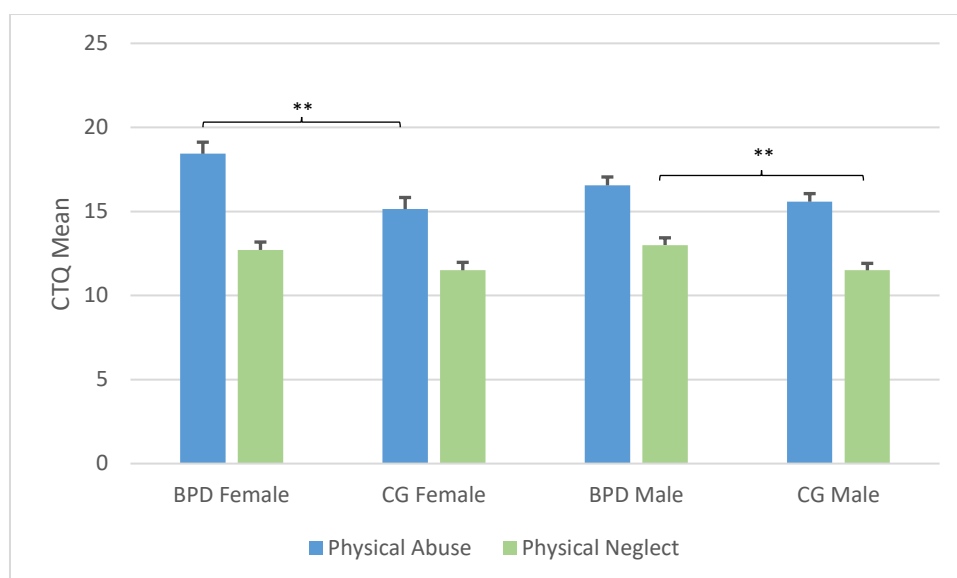

Figure S2. Overall CM Load, Sexual Abuse, & Experience of Inconsistency: Marginal Means & Significance.



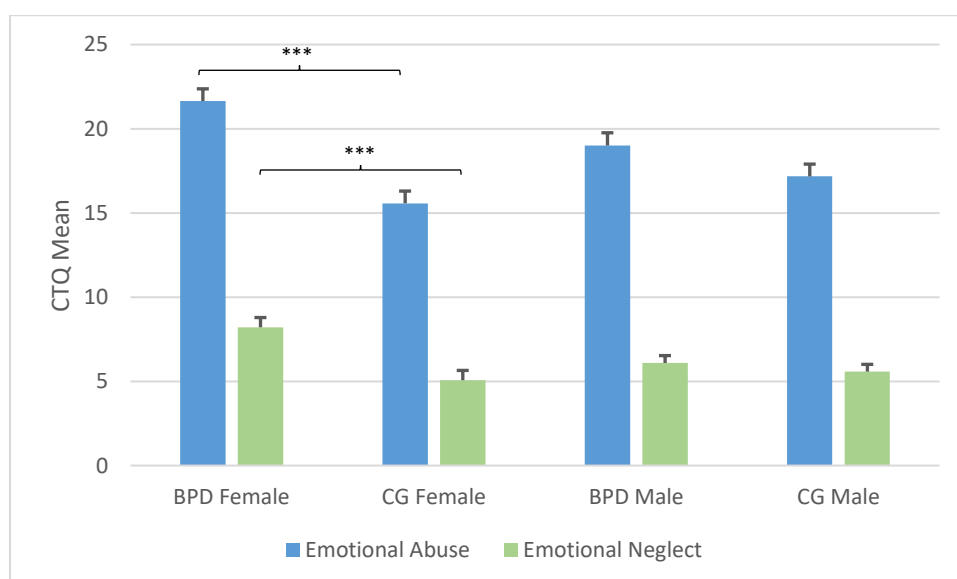

Figure S3. Physical Abuse and Physical Neglect: Marginal Means & Significance.



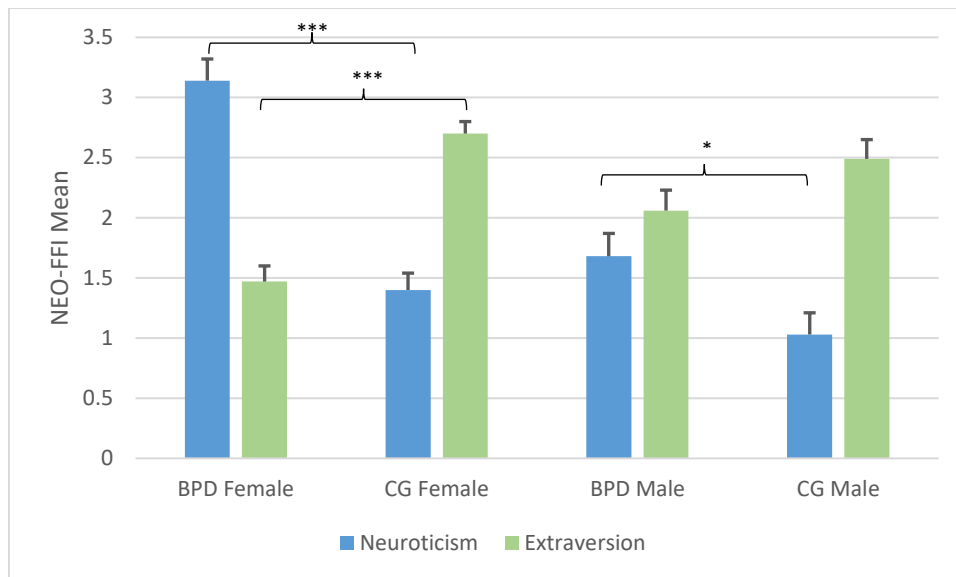

Figure S4. Emotional Abuse and Emotional Neglect: Marginal Means & Significance.



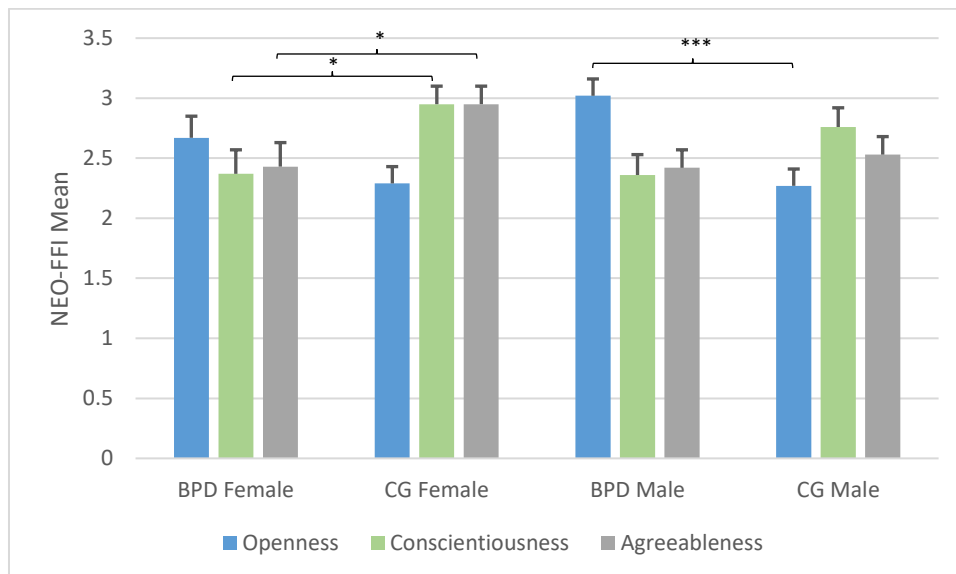
