Showing the relations in crocodilians between the cardiac chambers and the arteries, FP foramen of Panizza located between systemic (right-sided, RAo) aorta, emerging from the left ventricle, and the vis-ceral (left-sided, LAo) aorta, emerging from the right ventricle (adapted from [9]). Cc carotid arteries, LA left atrium, LV left ventricle, PA pulmonary arteries, PV pulmonary veins, RA right atrium, RV right ventricle, SC subclavian arteries, VC cardinal veins. Note the caudal connection between visceral aorta (LAo), providing the gut, and the systemic aorta (RAo).
