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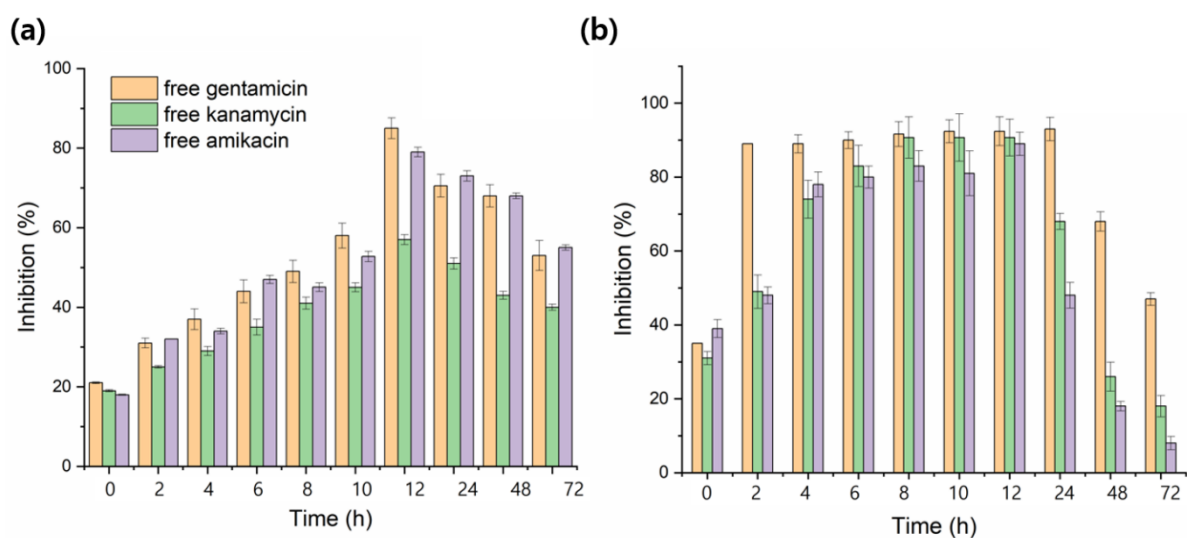


Figure S1. Antibacterial activities of free gentamicin, kanamycin, and amikacin for 72 h.

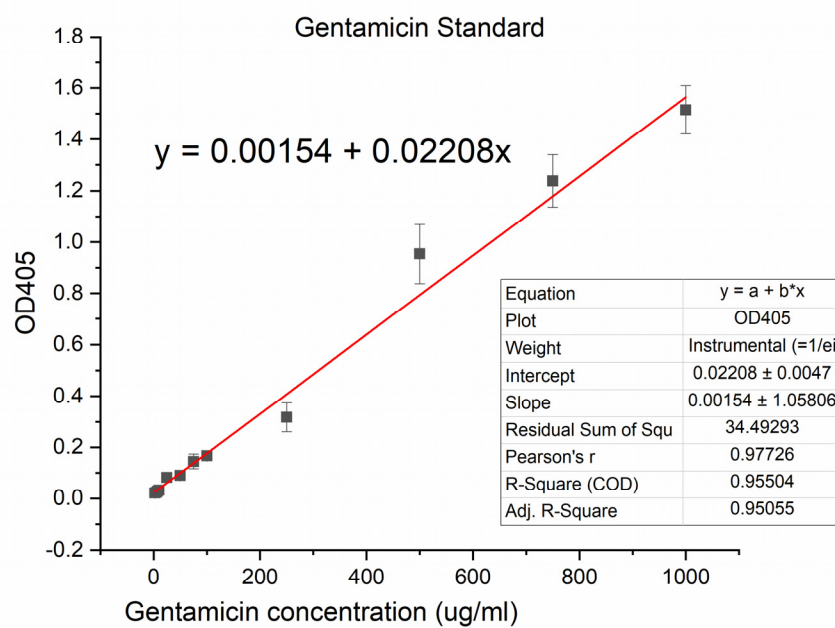


Figure S2. Gentamicin concentration-OD₄₀₅ standard curve.
