Dr. Elizabeth New is an Associate Professor at the University of Sydney (Sydney, Australia). Dr. Elizabeth New's research interests include chemical biology, bioinorganic chemistry, molecular imaging, redox sensing and metal ion sensing. Dr. Elizabeth New received her PhD in 2010 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising 74 publications in peer-reviewed international journals and an international patent. Her total citations number is over 3000 (according to Web of Science) and her Hirsch index is 26. She is clearly a rising star in the field of optical sensing. As a single applicant, Dr. Elizabeth New has secured funding of more than USD 40 million since 2009. This is an outstanding achievement in today's competitive environment.
