We are pleased to announce the “*Climate* 2022 Best Paper Award” for research and review articles published in *Climate* from 1 January to 31 December 2022. One review and one research article will each receive an award. The papers will be selected after a thorough evaluation by the *Climate* Award Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Dr. Steven McNulty. The winners will be announced in February 2024.

2022 BEST PAPER AWARD

Eligibility for the award:

- Papers published in *Climate* from 1 January to 31 December 2022;
- Open to all career levels;
- Both regular and Special Issue submissions will be considered.

Selection Criteria:

The papers will be selected by the *Climate* Award Committee according to the following criteria (data source: Web of Science (Clarivate Analytics)):

- Scientific merit and broad impact;
- Originality of the research objectives and/or the ideas presented;
- Creativity of the study design or uniqueness of the approaches and concepts;
- Clarity of presentation;
- Citation and download rates in 2023.

Prizes:

- One review award: 500 CHF and a chance to publish a free paper in *Climate* in 2024 after peer review;
- One research article award: 500 CHF and a chance to publish a free paper in *Climate* in 2024 after peer review;
- Each winner will also receive a e-certificate.

The winners will be announced on the *Climate* website by the end of February 2024.
