Dr. Lambertini is an assistant professor and consultant for medical oncology at the IRCCS Policlinico San Martino Hospital—the University of Genova in Genova, Italy. He is mainly focused on the care of breast cancer patients and is deeply involved in breast cancer research. Dr. Lambertini received his doctoral degree in medical science in 2018 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising 197 peer-reviewed publications in internationally recognized journals. Dr. Lambertini's Scopus scientific citations number is 3423, and his Hirsch index is 31. He is also a member of the guideline group for fertility preservation in cancer patients for the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO), the European Society of Human Reproduction and Embryology (ESHRE), and the Italian Association of Medical Oncology (AIOM).

He is clearly a rising star in the field of clinical breast oncology. Please join us in congratulating the awardee, Dr. Matteo Lambertini, for his outstanding achievements.

As the awardee, Dr. Lambertini will receive a prize of CHF 2000, the opportunity to publish a paper free of charge in *Current Oncology* before 31 December 2022 after peer review, and an electronic certificate.
