Dr. Bishal Gyawali received his PhD in 2017 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising 157 peer-reviewed publications in internationally recognized journals. Dr. Bishal Gyawali's Scopus scientific citations number is 15815 and his Hirsch index is 26. Furthermore, he is a member of the WHO Drug Policy Committee, ASCO Health Equity and Outcomes Committee, ESMO Global Policy Committee, and ESMO-Magnitude of Clinical Benefit Scale Working Group.
