# 2022 BEST PH.D. THESIS AWARD

Dear Colleagues,

The journal *Genes* (MDPI, Switzerland, ISSN 2073-4425, <https://www.mdpi.com/journal/genes>) is inviting applications for the *Genes* 2022 Best Ph.D. Thesis Award. This prize will be awarded to a PhD student who is about to graduate or participate in graduation thesis defenses in the field of genes. Applications will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee consisting of senior scholars from the *Genes* Editorial Board.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- The candidate must be a PhD student who is going to graduate or participate in graduation thesis defenses.
- The PhD thesis must be original work.
- The PhD thesis must be defended between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2022.

### Required Application Documents:

- An executive summary of the PhD thesis in English, of around 3000 words;
- A letter from PhD supervisor recommending the candidate for consideration for this award;
- The candidate's CV, including a list of publications connected with the thesis;
- An electronic copy of the PhD thesis;
- A scanned copy of the PhD diploma (or a certificate showing they are studying at a university or research institute as a PhD student who is going to participate in graduation thesis defenses).

### Selection Criteria:

- Quality of the resume and publications;
- Relevance of the candidate and research description;
- Novelty of the candidate's PhD thesis;
- Strength of the recommendation letter;
- Anticipated academic potential;
- Originality and impact of the research.

### Prizes:

- Bonus (500 CHF);
- A certificate;
- An offer to publish a featured paper in *Genes* with the article processing charge (APC) waived before the end of 2023.
