- We are especially interested in papers that track physical activity from childhood/adolescence to adulthood or intergenerational transmission of physical activity.
- Additionally, associations of physical activity in lifespan and health problems (e.g., overweight, obesity), symptoms (e.g., hypertension), morbidity or mortality are warmly welcomed.
- Papers that concentrate on special population groups are well accepted.
