This award provides financial support for the winner to attend an international conference relevant to the research focus of *Marine Drugs* in 2022, in order to hold a presentation, present a poster, or both.

2021–2022 TRAVEL AWARD

FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS OR PHD STUDENTS

Candidate Requirements:

- Postdoctoral fellows or PhD students (proof required);
- Plans to attend an international conference in 2022 (oral or poster presentation).

Required Application Documents:

- Information of the conference that the applicant is planning to attend and an abstract that will be submitted to the conference;
- Curriculum Vitae and list of publications of the applicant;
- Justification letter describing the focus of the research (max. 800 words);
- Letter of recommendation from the supervisor, research director, or department head, which also confirms the applicant’s status as a postdoctoral fellow/ PhD student.

The winner will be awarded CHF 1000 and a certificate.

Please submit your application for the *Marine Drugs* 2021–2022 Travel Award online by 30 June 2022. The winners will be announced on the *Marine Drugs* website at the end of July 2022.
