Gastrointestinal dysfunctions affect many children, with a significant impact on pediatric health care. Abnormal gastrointestinal motility/function is found in children with common. less disabling conditions. such gastroesophageal reflux and irritable bowel syndrome, and in rarer but life-impairing diseases, such as in a subgroup of children with intestinal failure (IF), including SBS and PIPO. Dietary management aims to improve nutritional status and also to minimize debilitating and potentially lethal consequences associated with gastrointestinal function, and it could require a complex nutritional approach. The purpose of this Special Issue is to provide new insight into the dietary management of pediatric gastrointestinal dysfunctions to help improve the care of the affected patients.
