High-risk neuroblastoma accounts for almost 15% of all pediatric cancer-related deaths, with overall survival rates lower than 50%. This situation become murkier when the majority of neuroblastoma patients relapse with an aggressive, refractory, and metastatic disease, with an overall survival rate of only 10%. Therefore, understanding the causes of neuroblastoma pathogenesis, relapse, and developing novel therapeutic approaches is mandatory to effectively cure neuroblastoma.
